

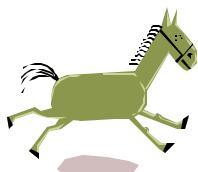


Summer Horsemanship Program

General Information

- * Must be registered with the SWF horsemanship program.
- * Each session is limited to 8 to 12 riders.
- * Must be able to ride in a group lesson.
- * Students will be assigned a horse & equipment to care for during the week.

Daily Activities Include:

- * Stable maintenance
- * Daily mounted lessons
- * Unmounted horsemanship lessons
- * After lunch games
- * Incentive Awards
